PHOSPHONATE as the only active constituent.

Critical Use Comments:

Apply at 7 day intervals when conditions favour disease development. Use a sprayer that is appropriate for applying enough water to ensure thorough coverage of the crop.

Withholding Period:

NOT REQUIRED WHEN USED AS DIRECTED.

THIS PERMIT provides for the use of a product in a manner other than specified on the approved label of the product. Unless otherwise stated in this permit, the use of the product must be in accordance with instructions on its label.

TO AVOID CROP DAMAGE:

The sensitivity of some species and varieties of the crops to be treated under this permit has not been fully evaluated. It is advisable, therefore, to only treat a small number of plants to ascertain their reaction before treating the whole crop.
